Lawrence Osborne's newest novel is a tour-de-force set in contemporary Cambodia that recalls Graham Greene, Paul Bowles and Ian McEwan in its brilliant atmosphere, tautly wound narrative and indelible characters.

When Robert Grieves crosses the Thai-Cambodia border, he is simply a lone, aimless traveler: a British English teacher in his early thirties, abroad on holiday with no particular destination in mind. But when he unexpectedly wins a large sum of money at the gambling table, his fate becomes intertwined with the lives of a cast of others: people who are strangers to him now but whose choices will affect his future in surprising – and often dangerous – ways.

Filled with Hitchcockian twists and turns, suffused with the steamy heat and pervasive superstition of the Cambodian jungle, and unafraid to confront uneasy questions about destiny, luck, and the machinations of fate, HUNTERS IN THE DARK is a masterful novel that feels like an instant classic.







At the center of it all is Gus Lindquist, a pill-addicted, one-armed treasure hunter obsessed with finding the lost treasure of pirate Jean Lafitte. His journey brings him into contact with a wide array of memorable characters, including a couple of small-time criminals prone to some truly hysterical banter, the smooth-talking oil company middleman out to bamboozle his own mother, and some psychotic drug smuggling twins who could have walked in off the set of *Breaking Bad*. Initially, the narrative threads seem entirely distinct, but as the story progresses, the connections become clearer, the tension and action ramp up, and everything begins to come together. THE MARAUDERS is part pulp fiction and part Southern gothic swamp noir. It's a literary beach read that's compelling, sad, dark, funny, relevant, and meaningful.

Tom Cooper has been published in dozens of literary magazines and journals. His stories have been four times nominated for the Pushcart Prize. He lives in New Orleans.

The folks in Marco Leland's small New England town would say he's just your average, everyday guy. And that's just how Marco likes it. Sure, the life he's chosen may not be much of a challenge to someone with his gifts, but Marco is content with his quiet and peaceful existence. That is, until an old government friend presents him with an irresistible mystery--one that Marco seems uniquely qualified to solve: it seems that a team of DARPA scientists has invented a device that could make teleportation a reality. 





Kate Bolick, who wrote the 2011 cover story in *The Atlantic* called "All the Single Ladies," is like a number of single women we know: unmarried, divorced or widowed. Women today are turning their backs on hearth and home—adopting a fly by the seat of their pants lifestyle that may or may not bring them the happiness they seek. But if Kate Bolick's original and bold book proves anything, it is that single women are on to something, and there is a reason we are curious about what they do with themselves and who they think they are. The book Kate Bolick is writing, like the article that inspired it, offers an unconventional answer to some pesky, common questions lobbed at women: when are you going to get married? Or, do you see children in your future?

Instead of offering yet another statistic-packed, anecdote-rich socio-cultural exploration of this recent demographic feature of the way we live today, Kate has done something more daring and emotionally rewarding: she takes us deep inside her own imagination and life and introduces us to the writers—all women, most single for the majority of their lives—whose careers, personal lives and most important art have guided her in her own personal search for another way to live. You will recognize the names of some of these writers and artists, many born in the 19th century:

Edna St. Vincent Millay (who was sent to Europe by Vanity Fair in exchange for satirical essays and where she had adventures and dalliances), Edith Wharton (who moved with her wealthy family to Europe to avoid the Reconstruction period), and others you might discover for the first time like Ganna Walks (Polish, but born in Belarus), Neith Boyce, Elsie de Wolfe and several others, all of whom lived lives of shocking modernity.

This chorus of esteemed bachelorettes is brought to us through the story of Kate's own single life, which she explores through the city that made her an adult: New York. She doesn't shy away from sex, from morning-after regrets, from talking about women and, oh my god the only thing worse than not having a man, ambition and from discussing why even the idea of an adult woman living alone—in spite of the millions who are doing it—still provokes debate. This book is also shot through with a love story to bad boys, you know the ones who are great to date if not to usher in forever.

Kate Bolick's book is the story of a woman's coming of age by herself. It is also the story of a woman learning to live by herself, on her own terms, by her own wits and under her own house rules.

Kate Bolick is a contributing editor to *The Atlantic*. She was previously the culture editor to *Veranda* magazine. She lives in New York.



Just down the road at Number 31 was the "mad sadist" Theodor Dannecker, an Eichmann protégé charged with deporting French Jews to concentration camps. And Number 84 housed the Parisian headquarters of the Gestapo, run by the most effective spy hunter in Nazi Germany. From his office at the American Hospital, itself an epicenter of Allied and Axis intrigue, Jackson smuggled fallen Allied fighter pilots safely out of France, a job complicated by the hospital director's close ties to collaborationist Vichy.

After witnessing the brutal round-up of his Jewish friends, Jackson invited Liberation to officially operate out of his home at Number 11--but the noose soon began to tighten. When his secret life was discovered by his Nazi neighbors, he and his family were forced to undertake a journey into the dark heart of the war-torn continent from which there was little chance of return. Drawing upon a wealth of primary source material and extensive interviews with Phillip Jackson, Alex Kershaw recreates the City of Light during its darkest days. The untold story of the Jackson family anchors the suspenseful narrative, and Kershaw dazzles readers with the vivid immediacy of the best spy thrillers. Awash with the tense atmosphere of World War II's Europe, AVENUE OF SPIES introduces us to the brave doctor who risked everything to defy Hitler.

America's most trusted broadcast journalist uncovers the deadly threat of cyber warfare and offers solutions for how we can prepare.

When we think of cyber security, many of us think about identity theft or perhaps denial of service attacks. What we don't think about is the water we drink, the electricity we rely on to power everything from subway trains to lifesaving hospital equipment, and the phone and internet systems that serve as vital lifelines in an emergency. One well-placed cyber attack could cripple our infrastructure to a degree that would dwarf natural disasters like Hurricane Sandy--and Koppel convincingly argues that this is not a question of if but when.

Drawing on interviews with cyber security experts and others, Koppel demonstrates that we are completely unprepared for dealing with a cyber attack and offers solutions for how we can plan for this inevitability, both on the national and the individual level.

With the recent revelations about massive breaches of information from hackers in countries like North Korea and Russia, this topic is ever more important, and Koppel, one of the most trusted newsmen and respected across political spectrum, is just the person to give us this wake up call.

Ted Koppel, a thirty-seven-year veteran of ABC News, was anchor of *Nightline* from 1980 to 2005. He has won every significant television award, including thirty-two Emmys, six Peabodys and nine Overseas Press Club Awards. Before creating *Nightline*, he was a foreign, domestic, and war correspondent and bureau chief for ABC, and its chief diplomatic correspondent.

In OBJECTIVE TROY, Scott Shane, national security reporter for the *New York Times*, tells the riveting story of the advent of the drone, tapping his unparalleled access to the top sources in the intelligence community, the armed force, and the Obama administration whose military policies have come to be defined by this lethal homing weapon.

The larger narrative of the drone era is anchored by the immense, frantic manhunt for Anwar al-Awlaki, the first US citizen to be deliberately targeted for assassination by his own government. As far as the President was concerned, terrorist leader Awlaki had declared war on America and America had, in turn, declared war on him. Awlaki (code named "Objective Troy") evaded Obama's efforts for a year and spent that time taunting the President--mocking him online, and falsifying terrorist threats against Obama's native Chicago. Shane writes a white-knuckled, thrilling account of how Obama finally cornered Awlaki, while exposing a new type of warfare that has profound, lasting implications that extend well beyond the military and leak into our everyday lives.

The drone wars continue to dominate headlines and, sadly, the conflicts in the regions targeted by the US show no signs of abating. The stakes for this kind of warfare couldn't be higher--and raise issues of government surveillance, increasingly complex weapon technology, and unclear oversight. This highly relevant topic is of great importance today and Scott Shane, who has deep access to hard-to-reach sources, is the veteran journalist to tell it.

In March 2013, the *New York Times* published an obituary for Yvonne Brill. It began: "She made a mean beef stroganoff, followed her husband from job to job, and took eight years off from work to raise three children." It wasn't until the second paragraph that readers discovered why the *Times* had devoted several hundred words to her life: Brill was a brilliant rocket scientist who invented a propulsion system to keep communications satellites in orbit, and had recently been awarded the National Medal of Technology and Innovation.

The obituary--and consequent outcry in response--highlighted not only that women in science are often treated with less respect than their male counterparts, but also that there are still so few women in the STEM fields (science, technology, engineering, and medicine). This is in part because they are lacking the critical encouragement and support they need to help them advance.

Covering Nobel Prize winners and major innovators, as well as lesser-known but hugely significant scientists who influence our every day, these engaging profiles span centuries of courageous thinkers and illustrate how each subject's ideas developed, from their first moment of engagement with science through the research and discovery for which they're best known. Finally, it gives these 52 lives the attention and respect they deserve--with the aim to encourage and inspire a new generation of girls to put on their lab coats.

- France: Irene Juliot-Curie won the Nobel prize in chemistry for the discovery of the first artificially produced radioactive element.
- Germany: Maria Mayer won a Nobel prize in physics for "discoveries concerning nuclear shell structure"
- Italy: Rita Levi-Montalcini won a Nobel Prize for discovering growth factors.
- Russia: Sophie Kowalevski was a pioneering mathematician. She opened a new area of research in theoretical mathematics.



Too much and not nearly enough, churning in hurricanes or frozen into icy "snowmaggedons," rain is a conversation we share, and this is a book for everyone who has ever experienced it.

She is the author of *Mirage*, which won the gold medal for best nonfiction in the Florida Book Awards and *Blue Revolution*, which was named by the *Boston Globe* as one of the top 10 science books of 2011. On a cloudy June morning in 2008, the cream of the international fashion world and French politics assembled at the Église Saint-Roch in Paris to bid farewell to Yves Saint Laurent, the preeminent designer of the later 20th century, whose work had accompanied, as a fellow traveler, the great changes unfolding in women's lives in his era. 

In the tradition of the best works of history that uncover a forgotten family story, such as *The Hare with Amber Eyes* or *The Lost*, THE PORCELAIN THIEF recounts journalist Huan Hsu's journey through the old and new worlds of China to find hidden treasure, reconnect with his ancestry, and come to terms with his hyphenated identity.

A conversation with his grandmother, the last living link to his family's life in dynastic China, ignites his desire to learn more about not only his ancestral heirlooms but also porcelain itself. Mastering conversational Chinese enough to launch himself into the countryside, Hsu sets out to separate the layers of fact and fiction that have grown up around both his family and China, and finally complete his family's long march back home.

Melding memoir, travelogue, ethnography, and social and political history, THE PORCELAIN THIEF takes the reader along with Hsu as he travels throughout mainland China and Taiwan to learn more about his family's fabled porcelain collection and, as a result, about the great-grandparents and estranged aunts and uncles he never knew. THE PORCELAIN THIEF is an intimate and personal way to understand the bloody, tragic, and largely forgotten events that defined Chinese history in the 19th and 20th centuries.

Huan Hsu, born in the Bay Area and raised in Salt Lake City, is a former journalist and the recipient of two Society of Professional Journalists Awards as well as receiving recognition from the Casey Foundation for Meritorious Journalism.
