Prolonged, multiple wars in the Middle East. Waves of immigrants crossing the borders. Ongoing economic recession. Increasing political polarization, often with religious overtones. Conflicts over ideologies that pit the progressive against the traditional. Sound familiar? These conditions not only describe the United States, but the situation of the Roman Empire in the third century. That situation led to religious persecution and the eventual collapse of the empire. In the middle of the third century, the Roman Empire was roughly the same age as the United States is now.

Authors Mike Aquilina and Jim Papandrea examine the practices of the Early Church--a body of Christians living in Rome--and show how the lessons learned from these ancient Christians can apply to Christians living in the United States today. The book moves from the Christian individual, to the family, the church and the world, explaining how the situation of the Early Church is not only familiar to modern Catholic readers, but that its values are still relevant.







In *WOULD YOU BAPTIZE AN EXTRATERRESTRIAL?* Br. Consolmagno joins forces with a fellow staff member of the Vatican Observatory, Fr. Paul Mueller, to shed light on some of the places where astronomy and religion might be thought to be in conflict. The approach, as in Br. Guy’s previous two books, is at a popular level. *WOULD YOU BAPTIZE AN EXTRATERRESTRIAL?* starts with seven deceptively simple questions in astronomy, questions asked of Vatican astronomers all the time, that illustrate areas where religious and scientific sensibilities overlap:

- How do you reconcile the scientific version of The Big Bang with the Genesis account of creation?
- How can you belief in resurrection and eternal life, given the inevitable heat death of the universe?
- Do you guys know something we don’t about the imminent end of the world?
- Why isn’t Pluto a planet, and why was the Vatican involved in that decision?
- What was the Star of Bethlehem – just a pious religious story, or an actual description of astronomical events?
- What really happened with the Church and Galileo? Could it have been avoided? Or was it inevitable?
- Would you baptize an extra-terrestrial?

For some questions, a straightforward theological or scientific answer is possible – and given. But in other cases, you really have to reframe the question; you’ve got to name and challenge all hidden presuppositions behind the question.

Brother Guy Consolmagno worked as a post-doctoral fellow and lecturer at Harvard University's Department of Astronomy, and MIT's Department of Earth and Planetary Sciences; served in the US Peace Corps, teaching physics at the University of Nairobi; and was a physics professor at Lafayette College in Pennsylvania, before entering the Jesuits as a brother in 1989. At the Vatican Observatory since 1993, his research explores connections between meteorites, asteroids, and the







What could be more familiar than the Christmas story — and yet what could be more extraordinary? The cast of characters is strange and exotic: shepherds and magicians, an emperor and a despot, angels and a baby who is Almighty God. The strangeness calls for an explanation, and this book provides it, examining the characters and the story in light of their biblical and historical context.

The circumstances of Jesus' birth are unusual, wondrous, and mysterious; yet they also follow a certain divine logic, a drama that had been unfolding since the beginning of time, a moment that God had prepared with care and precision. The evidence is in the prophecies and the foreshadowings, but also in the pages of history. Authors Scott Hahn and Mike Aquilina, who have written extensively on Scripture and the early Church, bring that evidence to light, dispelling some of the strangeness of the story. Yet they also make Christmas familiar all over again — but in a new way, by showing it to be a family story.

Christmas, as it appears in the New Testament, is the story of a father, a mother, and a child — their relationships, their interactions, their principles, their individual lives, and their common life. To see the life of this "earthly trinity" is to gaze into heaven. Along the way, the authors show the relationship between the great feast day (the Christ's Mass) and the Church's liturgy, the place of the angels in the story and in our lives, and the ongoing relevance of that humble cave in Bethlehem, that humble home in Nazareth.

Scott Hahn is the bestselling Catholic author living today. His books including *The Lamb's Supper*, *Reasons to Believe*, and *Signs of Life* and the forthcoming *Angels and Saints*. **Mike Aquilina** is the author of more than 20 books, including *Angels of God* and the forthcoming *Seven Revolutions*.




Appealing to readers of Rick Warren, Kerry Shook and Steve Furtick, this is a guide to personal renewal for those who are searching for an authentic connection to God.

For two decades, the motto "helping people find their way back to God" has described the mission of Community Christian Church, founded by brothers Dave and Jon Ferguson. The most common obstacle to faith is *not* believing in God. The problem is finding and connecting with the God we already believe in.

Drawing on the well-known story of the prodigal son, the authors show how most people set out with good intentions, only to find themselves floundering in what the authors call "spiritual amnesia." The authors hope to clear up this amnesia and help people remember what they once knew in childlike innocence: that there is a God who knows them, loves them, and has a dream for their life. They dare readers to engage in a 30-day wager with God by praying each day, "God, if you are real, make yourself real to me." Then they lead readers through five crucial awakenings that move them from doubt and confusion to love, purpose and meaning--and a personal relationship with God.

In an era marked by spiritual drift and confusion, the promise of "finding your way back to God" will resonate both with believers and seekers.

Dave Ferguson and Jon Ferguson are co-founders of NewThing, a church planting network (140 congregations; 7,000 leaders and staff; 50,000 attendees). Dave is also co-founder/president of Exponential, the nation's largest church leadership conference. In 2013, the conference had 5,300 attendees (sold out) with 60k participants in 93 countries via webcast. A spin-off, Exponential West Coast, is hosted by Saddleback Church (Rick Warren, pastor). They have written three church leadership books: *The Big Idea*, *Exponential*, and *Discover Your Mission Now*. They live in Chicago.





Respected author and religion commentator Phyllis Tickle has observed that every five hundred years, an unforeseen upheaval transforms Christianity. We are experiencing such a wholesale realignment today, and it is seen in the work and influence of emergence Christianity.

Doug Pagitt has helped steer this shift as a teacher, writer, and chief architect of new Christian understandings for the Hubble generation (in contrast to the previous, Galileo-era rationalism). Doug Pagitt is widely known as primary cofounder (with Tony Jones) of the emerging church, a movement that responded to stasis in the traditional church. Pagitt and others have been leaders in helping to shift the church's emphasis from internal matters to the questions, conflicts, and needs of people outside the church. He is the author of several books, including *A Christianity Worth Believing*, *Body Prayer*, and *Evangelism in the Inventive Age*.







This unpublished memoir from German-Catholic philosopher, Dietrich von Hildebrand, demonstrates his opposition to anti-Semitism, his prescient understanding of just how deadly Nazism and Hitler would be, and his courage as he prepared to flee Germany.

Dietrich von Hildebrand was the son of sculptor Adolf von Hildebrand and converted to Catholicism in 1914. He was a vocal opponent of Adolf Hitler and Nazism, fleeing from Germany to Vienna, Austria in 1933 upon Hitler's rise to power. There, with the support of Austrian Chancellor Engelbert Dollfuss, he founded and edited an anti-Nazi weekly paper, *Der Christliche Ständestaat* (The Christian Corporative State). For this, he was sentenced to death in absentia by the Nazis. When Hitler annexed Austria in 1938, Hildebrand was once again forced to flee. He spent eleven months in Switzerland, near Fribourg. He then moved to Fiac in France, near Toulouse, where he taught at the Catholic University of Toulouse. When the Nazis invaded France in 1940, he went into hiding, until, after many hardships, he was able to escape with his wife, son, and daughter-in-law to Portugal. From there, they traveled by ship to Brazil and then to New York in 1940.

This memoir was found in 2004 by the translator John Henry Crosby. Dietrich Von Hildebrand (1889-1977) taught philosophy at the Jesuit Fordham University in New York. Hildebrand retired from teaching in 1960 and spent the remaining years of his life writing. He is the author of dozens of books, both in German and English. He was a founder of *Una Voce America*. He died in 1977 after a long struggle with a heart condition.
