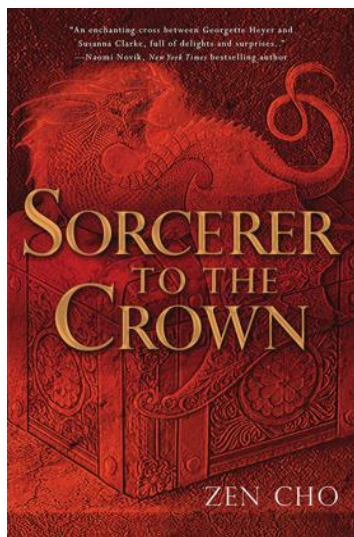

SORCERER TO THE CROWN is a historical fantasy set in London in the early 1800s. Zacharias Wythe is England's first black Sorcerer Royal. (As in, he's a black guy. Not as in black magic. He's the good guy!) But his life is still pretty awful. England is running out of magic, his colleagues are malicious and scheming to remove him from his position, and some think he killed his predecessor.

To restore balance, he must journey to find out why magic is running out. In his travels, he meets a woman with extraordinary powers, and together they set off on a path that will alter the nature of sorcery in Britain—and the world.

This book has everything readers could wish for in a historical fantasy: secret dragons, schoolgirl hijinks, confrontations at balls and overbearing aunts who are also witches.

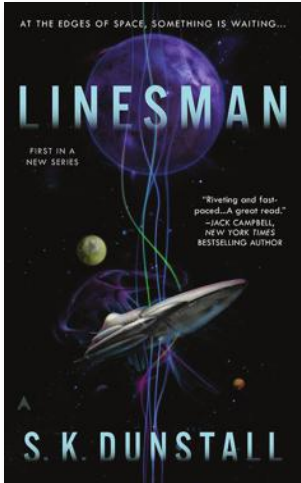

THE COLD BETWEEN is the start of a stellar military science-fiction series, with a hint of mystery and romance. It combines the close-knit crew dynamics of Star Trek with the big concepts and high stakes of modern SF classics like James S.A. Corey's Expanse series.

Central Corps starship mechanic Elena Shaw doesn't have time to grieve when her crewmate Danny is murdered during shore leave on the rich-but-lawless colony planet Volhynia. All evidence points to Treiko Zajec: former captain of one of the huge generation ships making up the mostly benevolent outlaw tribe known as PSI, and Elena's lover. But Elena knows Trey is innocent—he was with her when Danny was killed—and the cops are covering for the real killer.

As Elena Shaw investigates the murder, she uncovers a conspiracy that Trey had discovered, centered on the mysterious explosion of a Central Corps starship twenty-five years before—a secret that got him killed.

With ranking officers in the Central government implicated, Elena and her lover, outlaw captain Treiko Zajec, strike out on their own to expose the conspiracy, and the threat it poses to human civilization throughout the galaxy

As mechanic of the classified military starship Ananke, Althea Bastet's primary concern is always the safety of her ship. In this effort, the three-member crew is aided by stern oversight from members of the System, the all-powerful government.

When a charming thief who calls himself Ivan boards the ship, Althea and her two crewmates capture him—but not until after his escaping accomplice infects the ship's computer with an unknown virus.

Interrogator Ida Stays—envoy from the System—is always right. Based on her studies of Ivan's movements via the System's near-omnipresent surveillance, Ida is sure that Ivan is closely connected to a terrorist planning a major attack...she just has to prove it. But, as she learns when she arrives on the Ananke to interrogate him, Ivan is a very good liar.

As Ida gets closer to the answer she seeks, and discerns implications that could shatter the System's carefully controlled order, the starship's behavior grows erratic and dangerous to the crew. Althea slowly begins to realize that underneath Ivan's lies, he may be the only one who knows the truth that can save her ship.

And Althea cares more about her ship than she does the System.

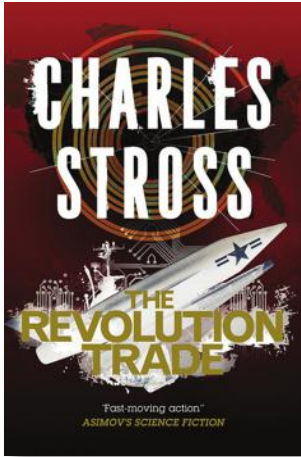

“Men in Black” meet James Bond in Charles Stross’s Laundry series of SF spy thrillers starring IT geek (and master of the supernatural) Bob Howard.

The one-time IT consultant now labors as a field agent for “the Laundry,” a super-secret British spy agency tasked with keeping mankind safe from evil magicks and wizardry that few of us recognize exists.

Now a junior manager within the Laundry, Bob realizes his job has gotten only tougher when a new threat arises from the darkness: a vampire-like infection has overtaken the traders employed by a merchant bank in London.

Bureaucracy and magical horror collide in the sixth book in the series, as Bob and his eccentric assortment of colleagues attempt to save the world from what appears to be a conspiracy between man and monsters.
