SERVES 2 TO 4 (MAKES 8 PANCAKES)
PREP TIME: 15 MINUTES

PREPARE INGREDIENTS

1 cup all-purpose flour
2 tablespoons sugar
2 teaspoons baking powder
¼ teaspoon baking soda
½ teaspoon salt
¾ cup milk
1 large egg
2 tablespoons vegetable oil
¼ teaspoon vanilla extract
Vegetable oil spray
½ cup blueberries

GATHER COOKING EQUIPMENT

2 bowls (1 medium, 1 small)

PANCAKES 101



If you have an electric griddle, it's perfect for this recipe. Just set the griddle to 350 degrees. You should be able to make all eight pancakes in one batch. This recipe can be doubled if you want to cook for a big crowd. If you want to serve the pancakes all at once (rather than as they come out of the pan), see page 000 for information about keeping pancakes warm in the oven.

START COOKING!

1. In medium bowl, whisk together flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. In small bowl, whisk milk, egg, oil, and vanilla until well combined.
2. Add milk mixture to flour mixture and stir gently with rubber spatula until just combined (batter should remain lumpy). Let batter sit for 10 minutes before cooking.
3. Spray 12-inch nonstick skillet with vegetable oil spray and heat over medium heat until hot, about 1 minute.
4. Use ¼-cup dry measuring cup to scoop ¼ cup batter into skillet. Repeat 2 more times, leaving space between mounds of batter (you want 3 pancakes to cook up separate from each other). Sprinkle each pancake with 1 tablespoon blueberries. Cook until bubbles on surface begin to pop, 2 to 3 minutes.
5. Use spatula to flip pancakes and cook until golden brown, 1 to 2 minutes. Transfer pancakes to plate. Repeat with remaining batter in 2 more batches. Turn off heat. Serve.

MAKE IT YOUR WAY

Pancakes are a blank canvas, so bring out your inner artist. You can work your magic at the table with maple syrup, honey, confectioners' sugar, cinnamon sugar, fresh fruit, and/or softened butter. Or you can cook your artistry right into the pancakes by adding **chocolate chips**, **chopped nuts**, **shredded coconut**, **sliced bananas**, or **raspberries** instead of the blueberries. Use 1 tablespoon of add-ins per pancake. Have fun, and try your own combinations.

YOGURT AND BERRY PARFAITS

SERVES 2
PREP TIME: 5 MINUTES
COOK TIME: 10 MINUTES

PREPARE INGREDIENTS

1 cup Greek yogurt
1 tablespoon honey
1 cup raspberries, blueberries, blackberries, and/or sliced strawberries
½ cup granola

GATHER COOKING EQUIPMENT

Small bowl
Whisk
Two 8-ounce parfait glasses (the kind you use for ice cream sundaes) or any 8-ounce glass tumblers
¼-cup dry measuring cup
1-tablespoon measuring spoon

START COOKING!

1. In small bowl, whisk yogurt and honey until smooth. Spoon one-quarter of yogurt-honey mixture into each glass. Top with ¼ cup berries, followed by 2 tablespoons granola.
2. Repeat layering process with remaining yogurt, berries, and granola. When you're done, you should have 2 layers of yogurt, berries, and granola. Serve within 15 minutes or granola will start to become soggy.

THE LAYERED LOOK

It's easiest to complete each step in both glasses, rather than make one complete parfait and then the second one. Why? Filling both glasses at the same time helps you divide everything evenly.



Layer yogurt, berries, and granola into each glass. Repeat with more yogurt, berries, and granola.

IT'S GREEK TO ME

Creamy Greek yogurt, fresh fruit, and crunchy granola make a delicious and wholesome start to the day or a great afternoon snack—and layering them in a glass makes this simple combination feel like a special occasion. Greek yogurt makes the creamiest parfait, but there's no rule against using another kind of yogurt. You can use regular yogurt, but since it is thinner than Greek yogurt (extra liquid has been drained from Greek yogurt so that it's really thick and creamy), the layers may not stay as well defined. We like the color contrast between plain (unflavored) yogurt and the fruit, but if you use sweetened or flavored yogurt, skip the honey.


EASY FRUIT SALADS

Fruit is a great way to start the day. For a special breakfast, you might want to make fruit salad. (Don't worry—no lettuce needed.) A fruit salad is a mixture of several kinds of fruit, each cut into bite-size pieces. It's nice to sweeten the fruit with a drizzle of honey or even good maple syrup. But don't use more than a squeeze or two—the fruit is already plenty sweet. Toss the fruit to make sure it's evenly coated with the honey. The honey will even prevent the fruit from turning brown. The best fruit salad has two or three kinds of fruit. Berries require little or no prep and pre-cut melon and pineapple are great choices.
