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





Milton Glaser: Graphic Design, perhaps the most famous book of its kind, explores the early decades of America's pre-eminent graphic artist. Glaser's work ranges from the psychedelic Bob Dylan poster to book and record covers; from store and restaurant design to toy creations; and magazine formats including *New York* magazine and logotypes, all of which define the look of our time. Here Glaser undertakes not only a remarkably wide-ranging representation of his oeuvre from the incredibly fertile early years, but, in a new introduction, speaks of the influences on his work, the responsibilities of the artist, the hierarchies of the traditional art world, and the role of graphic design in the area of his creative growth. First published in 1973, *Milton Glaser: Graphic Design* is an extraordinary achievement and indisputably a classic in the field.

Laurent Durieux is a famous Belgian illustrator who is well known by pop culture fans and collectors for his cult movie poster reinterpretations. Every one of his American exhibitions was sold out on opening night and attended by thousands of enthusiastic fans. This book will be his first monograph and will cover his entire career, with particular focus on his most iconic alternative movie posters (including *Jaws*, *The Birds*, *Vertigo*, and *The Master*).

The book includes a 6-page section of rejected and unpublished poster art and a foreword by filmmaker and Durieux collector Francis Ford Coppola.

Laurent Durieux was born in 1970 in Belgium. The 49-year-old Brussels illustrator and graphic artist spent two decades as a designer and teacher, and then became a star in the US thanks to a number of high-profile awards and marquee commissions, including a 2013 screenprint of *Jaws*, which caught the eye of the film's director, Steven Spielberg. Durieux was named one of the world's 200 Best Illustrators by the influential international advertising magazine *Lürzer's Archive* in 2011. Durieux's posters can be found in several prestigious cinema related institutions such as the Oscar Museum in Hollywood and the Cinémathèque Française in Paris, France, as well



Touko Laaksonen, also known as Tom of Finland (1920–1991), was an iconic and provocative artist who rose to cult status in the international gay community and beyond for his work celebrating gay archetypes and masculinity during a time when being gay was taboo. Created in partnership with the Tom of Finland estate, *Tom of Finland: The Official Life and Work of a Gay Hero* is a beautifully detailed visual biography full of rarely or never-before-seen documents from his archive. The text was completed just a few months before the death of the artist and was fully approved by him—making this book the only 100 percent approved biography of the gay legend responsible for creating the muscled, mustachioed gay archetype of the 1960s and '70s.

With an extensive biography, and suggestive photos and illustrations, this book brings to life the icon whose erotic illustrations of men influenced many artists, including Robert Mapplethorpe and Bruce Weber.

With chapters on Marcel Proust, Victor Hugo, Gustave Flaubert, Stendhal, Honoré de Balzac, Albert Camus, and of course Françoise Sagan, this is a delectable read for book lovers everywhere.





Since its publication nearly 70 years ago, George Orwell's *1984* has been regarded as one of the most influential novels of the modern age. Politicians have testified to its influence on their intellectual identities, rock musicians have made records about it, TV viewers watch a reality show named after it, and a White House spokesperson tells of "alternative facts." The world we live in is often described as an Orwellian one, awash in inescapable surveillance and invasions of privacy.

On Nineteen Eighty-Four dives deep into Orwell's life to chart his earlier writings and key moments in his youth, such as his years at a boarding school, where the strict and charismatic headmaster shaped the idea of Big Brother. Taylor tells the story of the writing of the book, taking readers to the Scottish island of Jura, where Orwell, newly famous thanks to *Animal Farm* but coping with personal tragedy and rapidly declining health, struggled to finish *1984*. Published during the cold war—a term Orwell coined—Taylor elucidates the environmental influences on the book. Then he examines *1984*'s post-publication life, including its role as a tool to understand our language, politics, and government.

In a current climate where truth, surveillance, censorship, and critical thinking are contentious, Orwell's work is necessary. Written with resonant and reflective analysis, *On Nineteen Eighty-Four* is both brilliant and remarkably timely.
