Using a model of the teeth, he explains to Nele what the various teeth are called and what they are for. Nele finds out what exactly is going to be looked at in her mouth and how the instruments work that will be used.

The book also contains instructions on the correct method of cleaning one's teeth and what kind of food is important for healthy teeth. And at the end, Nele can choose a small rubber animal to take home.

* The Hutz is a wild tree hero from the Arboori tribe that also call themselves the Shaggies. His mission is to protect his tree, the Hutz tree standing in Elvis's Granny's garden. The Hutz, however, does not have a very keen sense of responsibility and much prefers to roam around places inhabited by people, camouflaged as a dog. Otherwise he is characterised by bad manners and a big heart.
