### THE WAY OF THE WHITE ROSE AND THE SCHOLL SIBLINGS TO RESISTANCE

Sophie and Hans Scholl, Alexander Schmorell, Christoph Probst, Willi Graf, Kurt Huber and many others wanted to resist the suppressive totalitarian system of the Nazis. They distributed flyers in which they invited the German public to show passive resistance. With the aid of selected diary entries, letters and descriptions by the members of the White Rose, Anja Tuckermann has reconstructed these young people's road to resistance. What were their lives like during the dictatorship and the war? What emotions did they have? She chronologically follows their tracks from 1933 until Hans and Sophie Scholl were arrested in 1943 and the wave of trials that ensued, thus painting a comprehensive picture of events. The book lets us share these young courageous people's way to resistance until the very end: with empathy, authenticity and historical facts.
