Suspicion falls upon her family and friends, and she'll do anything to prove their innocence. The only problem (well, one problem, anyway) is that, as with most things involving magic and life in general, she's fairly useless at investigating. She thinks there may be a link between the death of the developer and the murder of the Zimmer family more than half a century ago, but it's going to take a lot of determination to figure out what it is. And what are Lord Ludo's wife — and his horrible, snobby, annoyingly-attractive son — hiding? Wisteria just wants to solve the whole thing so she can get back to the pub... or before anyone else gets hurt.

Roger Zelazny was born in Ohio, USA in 1937. By the time of his death in 1995. Roger Zelazny's awards included three Nebulas (out of 14 nominations), six Hugos (also 14 nominations), and two Locus Fantasy Awards. He was inducted into the Science Fiction Hall of Fame in 2010.
