It starts as a seemingly innocuous update at a Chicago high school: copies of a certain book are no longer allowed in the classroom. But it's not just one high school—it's *all* public Chicago high schools. The order is shrouded in unknowns—not even the high school principals know exactly why this is happening. All that's clear is this: The book, which tells a story of oppression, survival, and resistance against those in power, is seen as some sort of a threat, dangerous enough to ban.

Well, one other thing is clear: The students aren't going to let this go without resistance of their own. Written by the librarian who investigated the Chicago Public School system's 2013 censorship decision, ***Wake Now in the Fire*** is an inspiring story of student activism and speaking truth to power.

Jarrett Dapier is the 2016 recipient of the John Phillip Imroth Award from the American Library Association for his work exposing book censorship in the Chicago Public Schools. He is the author of several award-winning picture books for children.

AJ Dungo is a graduate of ArtCenter College of Design. He has worked with Nike, *The New York Times*, *The New Yorker*, *Bleacher Report*, Doubleday & Cartwright, *This American Life*, *The Wall Street Journal*, ProPublica, and Virgin Orbit. Getting off the subway in the Uplands, Paolo immediately gets lost and is about to end up in a bad situation when a girl named Jules and her friends usher him away. It turns out they're living the life he's always dreamed of. They spend their nights at the most exclusive clubs, have access to all sorts of entertainment, and have no real responsibilities. One night with them--and with Jules--just isn't enough. Soon, Paolo finds himself sneaking to the Uplands as much as possible and leading a double life. The closer he gets to Jules, the more he has to lie to her and risk the new life and friends he's made. **Salvage** is a beautifully illustrated romance about finding love in the unlikeliest of places and people, and embracing who you are, even when it's hard.

Renee Nault began her art career as an illustrator, and her vivid watercolors have appeared in books, magazine and advertising around the world. Renee works traditionally in ink and watercolor preferring the tactile qualities of paint and paper to digital tools. She is best known for her acclaimed graphic novel version of *The Handmaid's Tale* by Margaret Atwood, which she both adapted and illustrated. *Salvage* is her first original graphic novel.

There's no better writer to tell the colorful history of cocktails than David Wondrich, widely considered to be one of the world's foremost authorities on cocktails and a driving force behind the early-twenty-first-century revival in the classic American art of mixing drinks. In *The Comic Book Story of the Cocktail*, Wondrich teams up with comics artist Dean Kotz to trace the evolution of the cocktail. Beginning with the ancient days of wassail and hypocras (mixed drinks based on wine and beer), they narrate a tumultuous and vibrant history.
