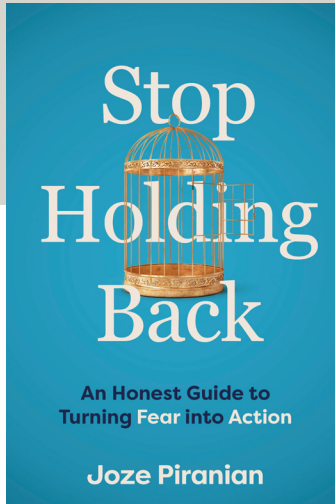
Every life follows a path. Elsie has just found the map to hers.

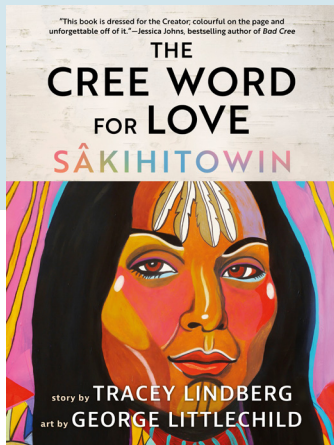

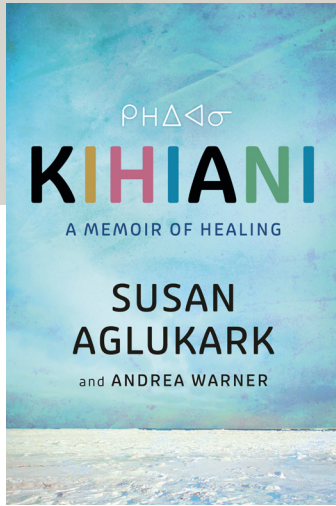
Their collaboration travels, season by season, mirroring the four rounds in ceremony, through the themes of the love within a family, ties of kinship, desire for romantic love and connection, strength in the face of loss and violence, and importance of self-love, as well as, crucially, a deeper exploration of the meaning of “all my relations.”

Together, art and story inspire and move readers to recall our responsibilities to our human and more than human relations, to think about the obligation that is love, and to imagine what it could possibly mean to have no Cree word for love. The result is a powerful story about where we find connection, strength, and the many forms of what it means to live lovingly.

TRACEY LINDBERG is a citizen of As’in’i’wa’chi Ni’yaw Nation Rocky Mountain Cree and hails from the Kelly Lake Cree Nation community. She is the author of *Birdie*, which was shortlisted for CBC’s Canada Reads, the Kobo Emerging Writer Prize, and the Georges Bugnet Award for Fiction and longlisted for the International Dublin Literary Award.

GEORGE LITTLECHILD is a Plains Cree artist who was born in Treaty No. 6 territory. He is internationally renowned for his work, and his collages and paintings grant viewers insight into the human spirit, the strong connection to our ancestors, the ways in which we view our worlds, and what needs to change.

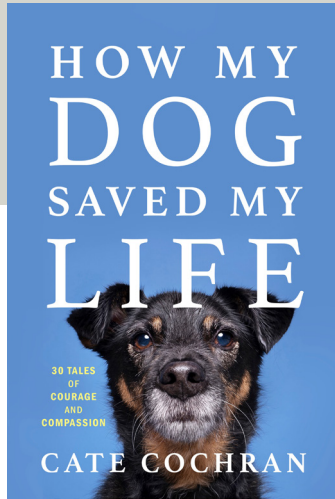
Profoundly honest and moving, *Kihiani* is the uplifting story of an Inuk artist's journey to healing and self-discovery

Born in Fort Churchill, Manitoba, but raised in Arviat, a predominantly Inuit community on the western edges of Hudson Bay, Susan and her six siblings grew up in a humble but loving home. But when she was eight years old, Susan's life was disrupted by a life-changing event, a distinct separation that created a schism inside her for many years and from which she continues to heal.

At fifteen, she started writing poems that spilled out of her, and when Susan had the choice to leave her community, she grabbed it like a lifeline. Eventually, Susan was approached by a producer making a compilation album of Arctic artists and years later signed with a major label for her third album, *This Child*.

The disruption and milestones, the turmoil and joy, the devastation and healing—this is Susan Aglukark's story of discovering her Inuk self.
